

3rd Saturday Paint Out - Historic Sutter Street, Folsom

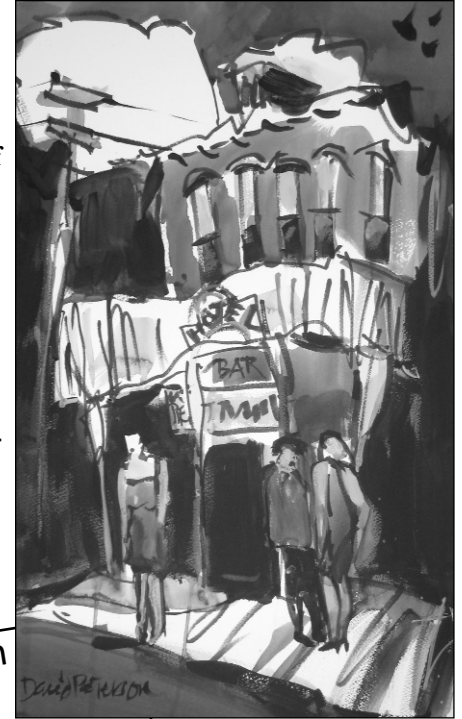
9:30 am to 1pm Saturday, November 19, 2011

We will meet on Sutter Between Riley and Wool, and paint in the three block area of Sutter Street that was the main business district of Folsom up until the 50's and early 60's.

Since the middle of the 19th Century, Sutter Street has always been the 'heart' of Folsom. A 3-block strip of stores, restaurants, and bars highlight a part of Folsom that has gone largely unchanged since 1851. We will observe the recently completed Sutter Street upgrade. Although the tenants have changed over the years, the look and feel of old Folsom truly brings you back to the days of the Gold Rush.

Some of the original stores have remained the same for over a century, such as the Folsom Hotel, which now is still a popular night spot on the weekends in its downstairs bar. There are some 80 businesses in the historic area. Public restrooms are near the Information Center (by the Caboose). This paintout is Light Rail accessible. There is a new parking garage. From all directions follow signs to Historic Sutter Street.

Be sure to check in at the Wine Gallery, 627 Sutter Street where the Sutter Street Artists show their art. We can have a 1pm show & tell and wine tasting.



Meet at the location at 9:30 am.

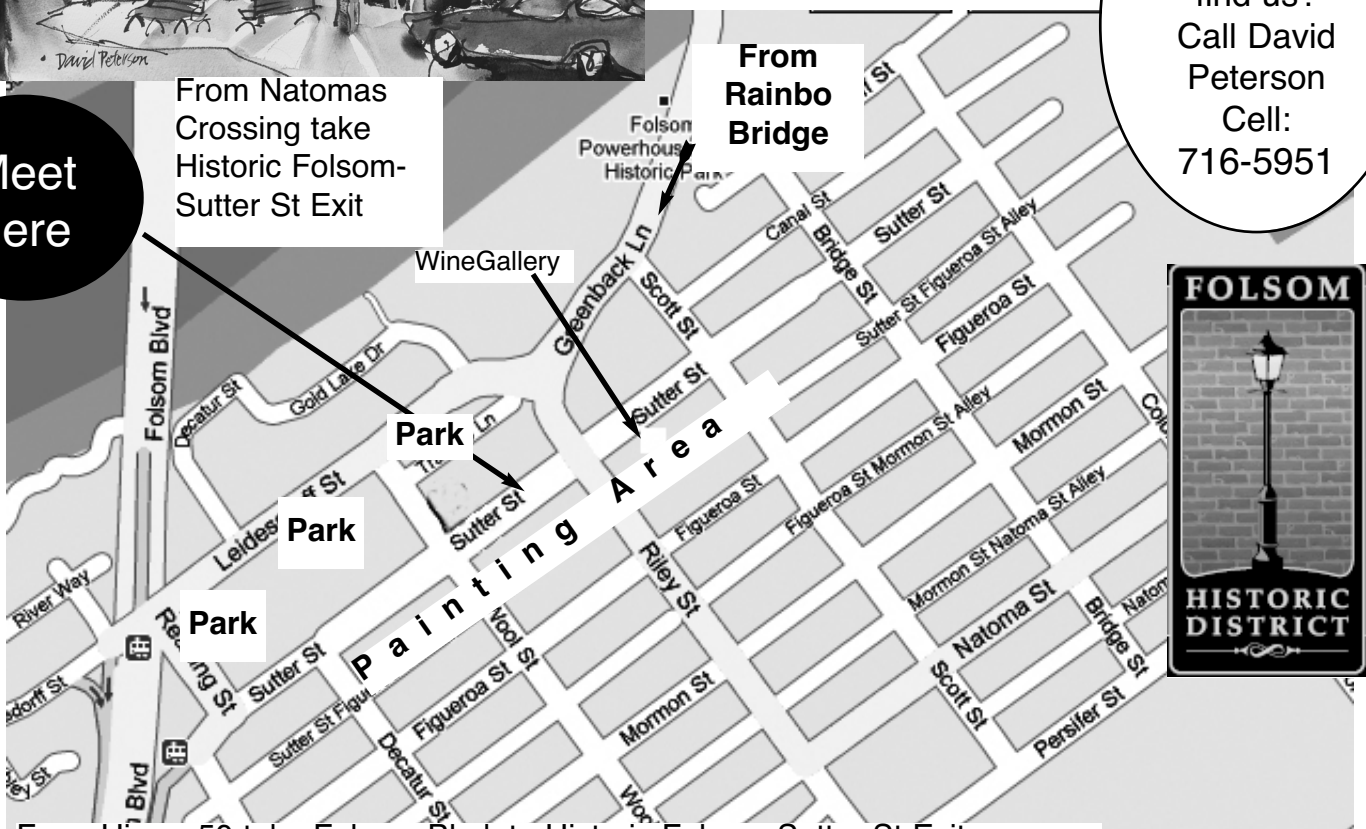
